Overview

The purpose of this guide is to walk through the process of setting up credentials for Experian credit reports.

Establishing a Relationship

In order to go live with credit, it is imperative to establish a relationship with Experian as soon as possible. The first step will be to contact Experian and enter into a contract. The contact information is listed below.

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Next Steps

LendingFront supports three different reports with Experian. The following reports are supported:

- Experian Premier Profile - This is the credit report that only pulls information about the business.
- Experian IntelliScore Plus - This is also known as the Blended Report. It combines information from the business and the owner.
- Experian Consumer Profile - This report only pulls information about the owner.

In order for LendingFront to pull Experian credit reports, LendingFront will need access to Experian NetConnect. Once this has been completed, the following information will need to be provided to LendingFront in order to enable Experian credit.
